

I think you remember that Mr. Obama, *the President of the United States, came to Hiroshima last year. He *prayed for all of the people who died in the *war and made a speech. On August 6, 1945, an *atomic bomb hit Hiroshima. About 140,000 people lost their lives. I think that Mr. Obama wanted to tell us that all countries have to think about a world without *nuclear weapons. I was moved by his speech.

I went to Hiroshima with my family last summer. I visited *the Hiroshima Peace Memorial Museum. I saw many pictures of the war and things that people used at that time. Those things made me very sad and I felt how *terrible the nuclear weapon was. Also, I saw the messages for peace from famous people. I found one from Mr. Obama among them. He said "Let's find the *courage to *spread peace together and *pursue a world without nuclear weapons." There were two beautiful *Orizuru* with the message. They were made by Mr. Obama. I felt they were the most beautiful things in the museum. We usually make *Orizuru* to pray for something. I think Mr. Obama made them to pray for world peace, just like many other visitors to the museum do.

After Mr. Obama's visiting, more people are going there than before. I think all the people who visit there feel that we should have *no more wars and try to keep the peace forever. We should remember what happened in Hiroshima. Wars won't make the world a better place. I want to tell everyone in the world that the most important thing for us is world peace. What can we do? Now, we need to find the answer to this question.

She began *wrestling when she was nine years old. Her father taught it to her and her older brother. She was more interested in wrestling than her brother. She enjoyed wrestling. She could join the *national competition, but she lost in the first *match. She cried and cried. After that she

said, "I want to be the best wrestler in Japan." Then she started practicing wrestling harder than before. Her parents decided to do anything to help her. Her mother *recorded all her matches. Also her father took her to many places to practice wrestling or join the matches. They always went by car and sometimes they spent all night in the car. She remembers her younger days and says, "The time in my father's car was the greatest time for me."

Her parents often tell her to do anything she likes to do. They say to her, "Continue wrestling if you want to, stop wrestling if you want to, practice if you want to win, don't practice if you don't need to win." The words from them made her strong. She said, "My *can-do spirit builds up *every time they tell me that I don't have to win." To become a stronger wrestler, she decided to leave Toyama and enter high school in Aichi. She practiced harder than anybody and she became one of the best wrestlers in Japan.

She joined the Rio de Janeiro Olympics in 2016 and reached the *final match against *Maria Stadnik. Tosaka was a few points behind. Then it happened in the last thirteen *seconds of the last match. She took Stadnik's leg and *held her down. She became the best wrestler in the world! After the Olympics, she thanked many people, especially her parents. She said, "My parents brought me to this place. They believed that I could win, even when I was weak." Then she showed her medal to her parents and put it around her mother's *neck. They looked so happy.

I think she is a great wrestler because she believes that she can do it and never gives up. It is important to believe in yourself and keep *making an effort for your dream. I have practiced *karate* for seven years. I want to be a strong player like her. My dream is to join the Olympics and win a gold medal. And I want to put my gold medal around my mother and father's necks in the future.




